Short Synopsis

Protests rage against the Indian Citizenship Amendment Act (2019), which persecutes Muslims. The director listens to the voices of the protesters and observes her own identity as a Muslim woman.

Long Synopsis

In 2019, the Indian Government passed the Citizenship Amendment Act, which made religion a criterion for citizenship and intended to exclude Muslims. Viewing this as discriminatory, working-class Muslim women gathered in Shaheen Bagh, Delhi, and began a nonviolent sit-in protest.

In an atmosphere of uncertainty and fear, the film follows the stories of women who sustained a peaceful protest for over a hundred days. They galvanized resistance across the country and transformed the protest into a nationwide pro-democracy movement, which became the most persistent show of opposition to Narender Modi's BJP government that took office in 2014.

Drawing on her identity as a Muslim woman, the filmmaker questions contemporary notions of belonging, patriotism, and identity in India by examining shared human responses to exclusion, polarization, and repression.

The film recounts how the women of Shaheen Bagh weathered institutionalized and societal repression to provide a precedent for a new form of public dissent in modern India.
